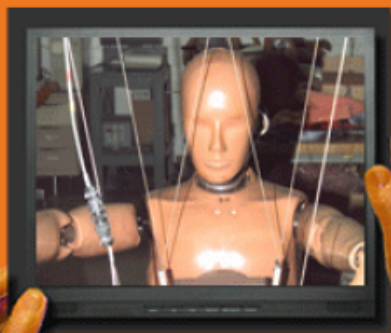


Calibration Services

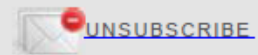
